MICHAEL SONICK, D.M.D.

BRIDGEPORT NATIVE DR. MICHAEL SONICK, D.M.D., IS A WORLD-RECOGNIZED PERIODONTAL and implant surgeon. He earned his doctorate from the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine and received his Certificate in Periodontics from Emory University and his implant dentistry training at the University of Gothenburg, Sweden and Harvard University. He previously taught at Yale University and UConn and teaches in the international program at the New York University School of Dentistry and throughout the world.

At his spalike boutique private practice, Dr. Sonick offers a combination of clinical and academic expertise and state-of-the-art technology including medical-grade CT scans, digital X-rays, computer imaging, cosmetic photography and electronic insurance commissions for faster claim processing. He holds Sonick Seminars, a clinically based series of live surgeries, hands-on sessions and lectures for general dentists, specialists and adjunct dental staff.

Dr. Sonick is on the editorial board of several dental publications and is a contributor to *Essential Dental Handbook: Clinical and Practice Management Advice from the Experts* and to *House Calls: How Doctors Treat Themselves and Their Own Families for Common Illnesses and Injuries*. He is co-editing the textbook: *Implant Site Development*, which details treatments to rehabilitate and restore function to the severely challenged dental patient.

Nothing gives me more pleasure than being able to restore a patient to dental health, especially when they have lost all hope.
